

Marine Zone Forecast

...SMALL CRAFT ADVISORY IN EFFECT THROUGH MONDAY MORNING...

Synopsis: The interaction between a frontal boundary located from northern Georgia to northern Mississippi and a surface high over the southern gulf will maintain strong winds over the northern gulf until the front moves through the area.

West winds 20 to 25 knots. Seas 5 to 7 feet with occasional seas to 8 feet. Dominant period 5 seconds. **Today**

West winds 15 to 20 knots. Seas 3 to 5 feet. Dominant period 5 seconds. Chance of showers and thunderstorms in the late morning and afternoon. **Monday**

Northwest winds 15 to 20 knots. Seas 3 to 5 feet with occasional seas to 6 feet. Dominant period 5 seconds. Chance of showers and thunderstorms. **Monday Night**

Northwest winds 10 to 15 knots. Seas 3 feet. Dominant period 5 seconds. Slight chance of showers and thunderstorms through the day. **Tuesday**

North winds 5 to 10 knots. Seas 2 feet. Dominant period 5 seconds. Slight chance of showers and thunderstorms through the night. **Tuesday Night**

West winds 5 to 10 knots. Seas 1 to 2 feet. Dominant period 5 seconds. Slight chance of showers and thunderstorms through the day. **Wednesday**

West winds 5 to 10 knots. Seas 1 foot or less. Dominant period 4 seconds. Slight chance of showers and thunderstorms. **Wednesday Night**

Southwest winds 5 to 10 knots. Seas 1 to 2 feet. Dominant period 4 seconds. Slight chance of showers and thunderstorms through the day. **Thursday**

Southwest winds 5 to 10 knots. Seas 1 foot or less. Dominant period 4 seconds. Slight chance of showers and thunderstorms in the evening. **Thursday Night**
